

Division's missions

Building an upgraded integrated E-data base for the civil record, in order to implement census of population and establishments and extracting social and demographical indicators with what best benefits decision and policy makers.



Data sources contacted to kick-off the E-linking process



Work phases completed



- Inventory of indicators from relevant directorates that can be provided through different source data.
- Examine the structure of databases and systems at each organization's level and the availability of data benefiting statistical indicators and the collection mechanism.
- E-linking with the Department of Civil Status and Passports and the Health Insurance department in an upgraded modern manner.
- To examine the quality of some of the records of the institutions with which the E-link is made in terms of completeness, coverage, repetition, concepts and definitions between what is used administratively and statistically to determine the compatibility of data for statistical work to build a civil register.
- The notes were confined to the records and the institution was approached with the notes that appeared in their databases.

Challenges and Solutions

Although there is a Prime Minister's letter facilitating the task of general statistics in building a comprehensive, up-to-date and accurate national register of population, social and economic data, source institutions are not cooperating with the Department of Statistics(DoS) in facilitating the task.

Solutions

- Linking with the electricity company to include the electricity meter numbers in order to identify the place of residence
- Establishment of steering and technical committees for data producing sources and the Department of Statistics.

Founding of a legal framework that obliges data sources to cooperate with DoS to build a comprehensive, up-to-date and accurate national register for population, social and economical data benefiting data users and provides key indicators that assists the decision maker in making plans.

Challenges

- The absence of a mechanism for building the bases of population characteristics such as the place of residence.
- Lack of cooperation between DoS and other institutions
- Statistical concepts are different form records concepts

Continuation/Challenges and Solutions

Solutions


- Discuss with ministries and institutions the possibility of preparing infrastructure for the purposes of E-linking.
- In case of cooperation with the Department of Residence and Borders, non-Jordanians are included through the foreign number

Challenges

- Inability to develop an information system through data sources due to lack of infrastructure for some sources.
- The coverage ratio through the records obtained will be only for Jordanians
- Delays in recording the facts of births, deaths, marriages and divorces.

Recommendations

- Use of international organizations' experts on administrative records (civil registries) who have been used in other countries to:
 - 1. Assessment of progress and quality of record linkages to produce socio-demographic population statistics



- 3. Further familiarizing the concept of administrative data and records and the initiation of their application in accordance with scientific methodologies and foundations.
- 4. Proposed program for statistical capacity development for civil registration and censuses based on administrative records
