Executive Summary

CBBH has readiness to produce monthly BoP against rest of the world. During this project their aim is to further analyze and improve the methodology used in the compilation and to produce the monthly BoP outputs for the past years beginning from 2015 with the revised methodology. After this task, CBBH will proceed to producing monthly BoP figures with the geographical breakdown included for a selected reference year. It is recommended that the methodologies are analyzed and revised also in the future, aiming towards preparedness to be able to meet the monthly BoP requirements following the data transmission calendar published by Eurostat.

Data transmission process to Eurostat presented by CBBH staff follows the process set by Eurostat. One way of improving the data consistency between other countries and international organisations could be the use Fusion Metadata Registry software. It allows the national agencies to download BoP DSD information defined by Eurostat and ECB in the system.

For this project it is recommended that data collection and processing, and data transmission processes are compared and if possible linked to the General Statistical Business Process Model (GSBPM) published by UNECE to further improve the general adaptivity of statistical production.

1. General comments

This mission report was prepared within the EU Twinning Project "Further Development of the Statistics System in Bosnia and Herzegovina". It was the first mission to be devoted to the Monthly Balance of Payments Statistics Component of the Project.

The purposes of the mission were:

- Assessment of the current status/progress on balance of payment
- Development of work plan for the project
- Mission report
- Preparation of ToR for next activity

The consultants would like to express their thanks to all officials and individuals from Bosnia and Herzegovina met for the kind support and valuable information, and which highly facilitated the work of the consultants.

2. Assessment and results

During the previous EU Twinning project (*Further Support to the Reform of Statistics System in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Component 5: Methodology for the compilation of the Monthly Balance of Payments Statistics developed and aligned with EU standards*), CBBH produced a preliminary monthly report of BoP against the rest of the world (RoW) for reference year 2019. CBBH



additionally prepared a methodological note on the compilation of monthly BoP. The current project begins with the same baseline as the monthly production has not been advanced since the last visit.

When it comes to the current state of preparedness of CBBH to disseminate monthly data, there is a process for the data transmission that is currently used in CBBH for quarterly and annual data transmissions. The data with BOP DSD dimensions is saved as an Excel file. The file is then converted to sdmx-format xml-file in Eurostat's EDAMIS online services. File goes through the STRUVAL and CONVAL validations and after these rules are met the file is uploaded to Eurostat.

CBBH is currently working with the implementation of an in-house application for data processing. They are trying to adopt the software as a data processing tool for trade credits and advances annual survey. There is also a financial plan on implementing the same processing tool on some other data sources.

CBBH staff is planning on applying their current monthly BOP methodology for years 2015-2018. After the methodology is applied they will analyse the results based on the consistency with the annual/quarterly BoP figures. After analysis the methodologies will be adjusted to better fit the annual/quarterly data and also to check whether new sources or indicators are needed for monthly production. The adjusted methodologies will be tested on data for following years.

Monthly BOP requirements from Vademecum are only met on aggregated counterpart level by CBBH. To meet the requirements CBBH should implement their plan on deriving the counterpart area distribution. Activities on GEO distribution will follow immediately after monthly estimates against the world are finalized. The current EU legislation does not oblige the consistency between monthly and quarterly BOP figures. However, CBBH is planning to follow the revision policy of monthly data to provide consistency with quarterly/annual data.

The timeline of the aforementioned next steps was discussed during the mission and written out into a work plan covering the rest of the project.

3. Conclusions and recommendations

CBBH has readiness to produce monthly BoP against rest of the world. During this project their aim is to further analyze and improve the methodology used in the compilation. Another objective in this project is to produce the monthly BoP outputs for the past years beginning from 2015 with the revised methodology. After the methodology is found satisfactory, the focus of the project proceeds to compiling monthly BoP figures with geographical distribution included in a chosen reference year and as stated in Vademecum.

It is recommended that the methodologies are analyzed and revised also in the future, aiming towards preparedness to be able to meet the monthly BoP requirements following the data transmission calendar published by Eurostat.

Data transmission process to Eurostat presented by CBBH staff follows the process set by Eurostat. One way of improving the data consistency between other countries and international organisations could be the use Fusion Metadata Registry software. It allows the national agencies to download BoP DSD information defined by Eurostat and ECB in the system. This information includes metadata, that is for example the defined dimensions, variable lengths and also hierarchies required in the transmission. Fusion Metadata Registry will hopefully in the future cover additionally the validation rules and datalines required in the transmission.
