

## Prices of Imported Goods

Background	Statistics Denmark collects monthly price data on Danish imported goods. This data is used to calculate price trends for Danish-produced goods sold on the domestic market. The results are published as the Producer and Import Price Index for Goods and can be found at <u>www.dst.dk/en</u> and <u>www.statistikbanken.dk</u> .
	Your company has been selected to participate in this survey, and we kindly ask you to re- port price information for selected product groups going forward. These product groups are specified in the attached reporting form.
First time submission	For each product group, please specify a number of representative products (typically 3-5) that best reflect the price trends of your company's goods. The selected products should not frequently change in quality, and their descriptions should be as precise as possible to ensure consistency in reporting over time.
Price definition	The prices collected for the Producer and Import Price Index for Goods should, as far as possible, consist only of sales prices to business customers (business-to-business), including internal transfer prices. If an internal transfer price is reported, please indicate this. The price should reflect the importer's actual purchase prices c.i.f. (Cost, Insurance, and Freight), in the currency in which the goods were traded, excluding all taxes and duties, at the two specified reporting periods in the form.
First-time reporting	Your company will receive an email via its digital mailbox, containing a blue information box with instructions on how to report. The deadline for submission is two weeks from re- ceipt.
Ongoing Reporting	Statistics Denmark aims to make the reporting process as user-friendly as possible to min- imize the administrative burden on businesses. Therefore, future reporting will be con- ducted online via Virk.dk. Once we receive the initial information, an electronic reporting form will be created for continued use. This requires a digital employee signature. If your company does not already have a digital signature, it can be requested at: <u>http://www.dst.dk/Indberet/om-indberetning.aspx</u>
	When it is time for the monthly price reporting, you will receive an email with a link to the online form. This email will be sent to the address provided during the initial submission.
Data confidentiality and legal basis	Reporting is mandatory under Section 8 of the Danish Statistics Act. All information is treated confidentially and used solely for statistical purposes.
