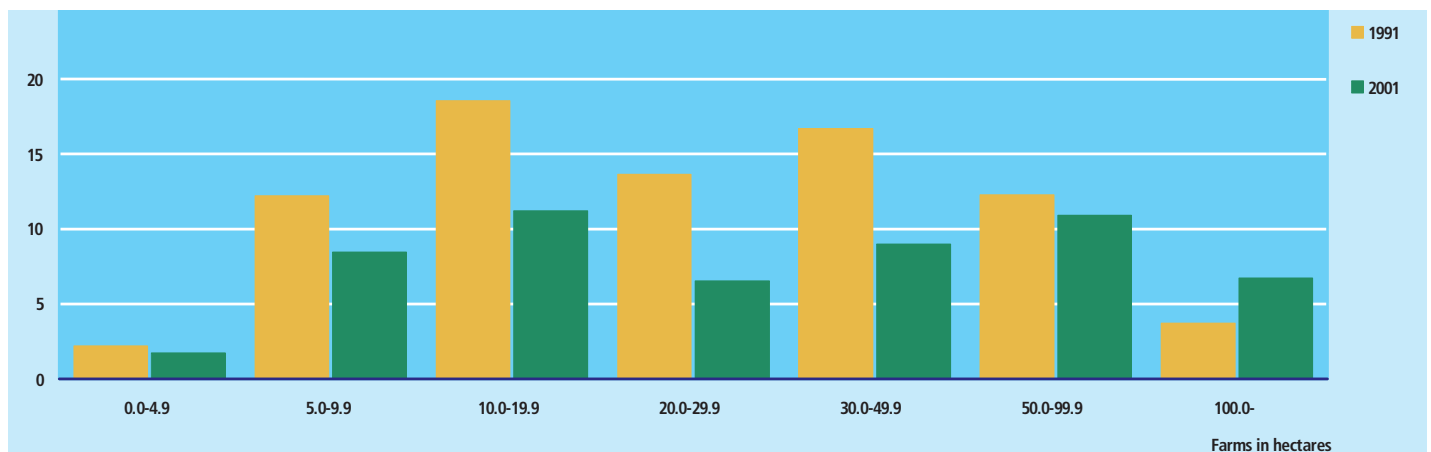

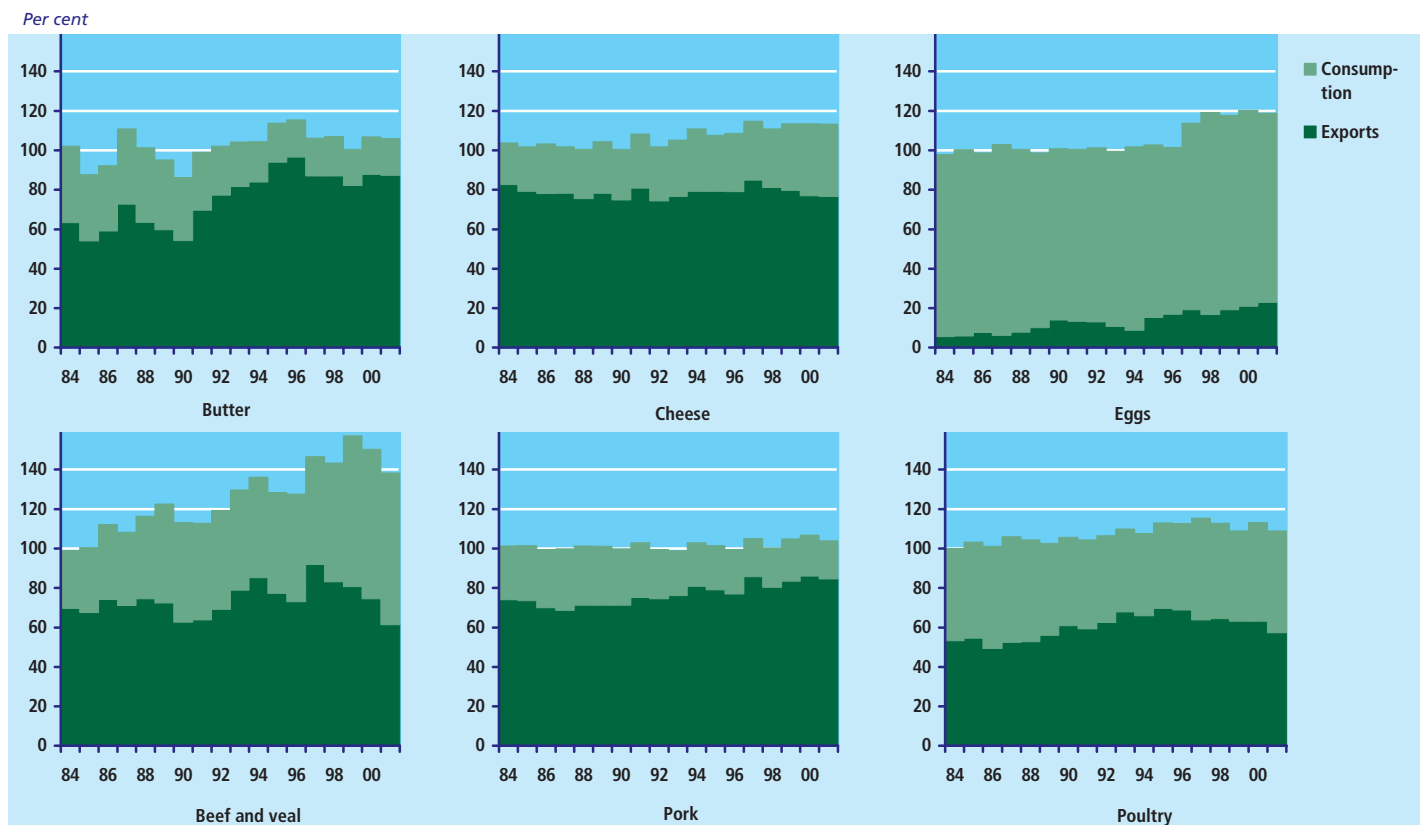

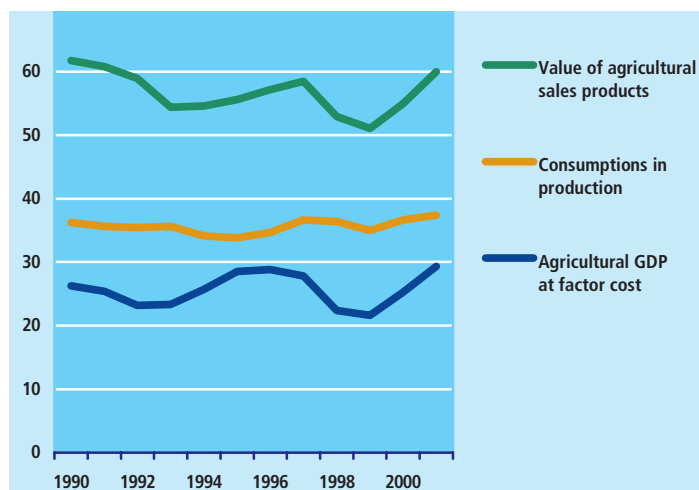

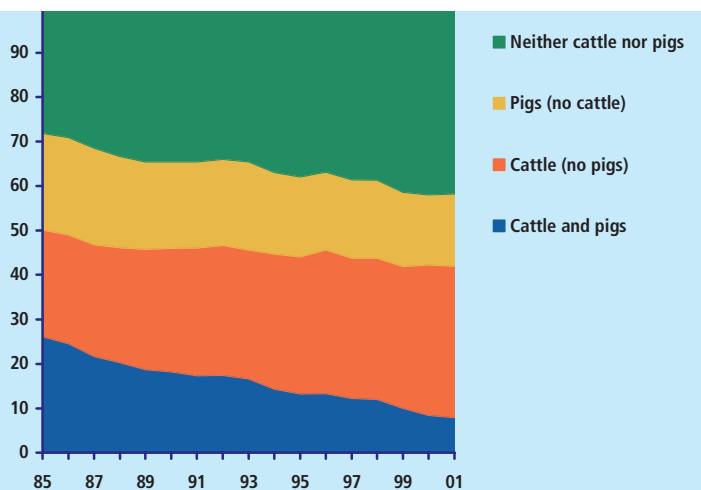
Main aggregates in agricultural GDP at factor cost^a
